Dave grew up on Long Island Sound sailing Blue Jays and Lightnings at Pequot YC. He is a Senior Certified Judge and has been a member of US SAILING Appeals Committee since 1986 and is currently the Chairman. Dave was the Rules Advisor and Afterguard Coach for Victory Challenge 2007, Sweden's America's Cup team, and the Rules Advisor for the 2008 U.S. Olympic Sailing Team in China. He has authored three books on the sport, Understanding the Racing Rules of Sailing, Winning in One-Designs, and Dave Perry's 100 Best Rules Quizzes.

Dave is a member of *Sailing World's* Hall of Fame, the recipient of US SAILING's W. Van Alan Clark, Jr. Trophy for Sportsmanship and the first recipient of the Captain Joe Prosser Award for Excellence in Sailing Instruction. He is best known for his clear, humorous and highly interactive presentations.
