



**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**CITY ISLAND YACHT CLUB Annual Day Race**  
**Sunday July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008**

The City Island Yacht Club invites you to participate in its Annual Day Race starting Sunday July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at Green Can "1" NE of Execution Rocks. The City Island Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority for this event.

**1. RULES:**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the US Sailing 2005-2008 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. All boats shall comply with all current YRA of LIS PHRF regulations.
- 1.3. The Minimum Equipment Recommendations of the YRA of LIS for category "C" races shall apply for all boats. These requirements are available on the YRA of LIS web site at [www.yralis.org](http://www.yralis.org).

**2. ELIGIBILITY:**

The regatta is open to vessels greater than 22' LOA with valid 2008 YRA of LIS PHRF certificates.

**3. ENTRY & FEES:**

- 3.1. All entries are to be made on-line on the City Island Yacht Club website: <http://www.cityislandyc.org/> by selecting the link to Regattas, and then Day Race. Entries must be completed *no later than Thursday July 24<sup>th</sup>*. Entries may also be mailed to City Island YC, Attn: Annual Day Race

**3.2. LATE ENTRIES:** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the race committee.

**3.3.** The Race committee reserves the right to reject any entry.

**3.4.** The entry fee for this race is \$45.00. Late entries must be submitted with a \$10.00 late fee. Except for entries not accepted by the Race Committee, entry fees are nonrefundable.

**4. QUALIFYING RACE:** This race is a qualifying race for the YRA of LIS Gitana, Sappho, Competitors, Kings Point and Mertz Trophies

**5. SCHEDULE:** The first signal for the start will not be made prior to 1025 hours. A maximum of one race is scheduled.

**6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be posted at City Island YC, and on the City Island Yacht Club website: <http://www.cityislandyc.org/> no later than 2000 hours on Thursday July 24<sup>th</sup> 2008. Division assignments shall be posted on the CIYC web site no later than 2000 hours Friday, July 25<sup>th</sup>. Sailing Instructions and Division assignments will be available from the Race Committee Boat prior to the warning signal.

**7. VENUE –** The race shall be in the waters of Western Long Island Sound, east of Hewlett Point and west of Matinecock Point. The starting / finishing area will be in the vicinity of Can One ("1") NNE of Execution Rock.

8. **COURSES** –All classes will have courses using Government Marks as described in the Sailing Instructions and course sheets.
9. **SCORING** – Scoring for all divisions will be calculated using the Time on Time method, using a Time Correction Factor based on the boat's PHRF rating ( $TCF=600 / (480+PHRF)$ ).
10. **PRIZES**: Prizes will be announced at the CIYC Clubhouse after the conclusion of the race and will be presented at the City Island Yacht Club Awards Brunch November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2008. The following prizes will be awarded:
  - 10.1. The THEODORE KAUFER perpetual trophy shall be awarded to the boat with the best overall performance in a Spinnaker Division.
  - 10.2. The HAROLD LAURIDSEN MEMORIAL perpetual trophy shall be awarded to the boat with the best overall performance in a Non-Spinnaker division.
  - 10.3. DIVISION TROPHIES- First place trophies will be awarded in each division. Second place trophies will be awarded if there are more than 4 entries and third place trophies will be awarded if there are more than 5 entries.
11. **RADIO COMMUNICATIONS:**
  - 11.1. Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on Channel 72.
  - 11.2. Except when seeking or rendering assistance, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive special communications not simultaneously available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. Contestants may not receive special weather, current or navigational information except by broadcast from a publicized source available to all competitors. Internet use is allowed for accessing all information publicly available at no fee.
  - 11.3. The Race Committee will endeavor to make courtesy announcements before and during the starting sequence on VHF Channel 72. All boats are encouraged to monitor this Channel prior to and during the start.
12. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**: All competitors are reminded of RRS, Rule 4, Decision to Race. City Island Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
13. **WELCOME**: The privileges of the City Island Yacht Club including the use of the restaurant, the pub and guest moorings will be extended from July 26<sup>th</sup> thru July 27<sup>th</sup> to all participants. After the race, all participants are invited to join us for complimentary refreshments and the announcement of awards. For mooring reservations call (718) 885-2487. The City Island Yacht Club Launch monitors Channel 72 and is available 24/7.
